A reminder: please do not use mobile phones on the school site and ensure you do not post any pictures of children at school, except for your own, on social media. You do not know which children are subject to safeguarding measures and whose location cannot be shared.

If you have accidentally shared images of children other than your own in their school uniform and at school on your social media recently, please take them down.
